Rio de Janeiro Final report and results

Red Bull Air race World Championship 2010



Japanese Pilot Yoshihide Muroya has finished 12th at the Rio de Janeiro round of the 2010 Red Bull Air Race World Championship. Hannes Arch won the race with Nigel Lamb 2nd and Paul Bonhomme in 3rd.

After the engine adjustment from last night Yoshi progressed his performance and managed to qualify in the Wild Card session. Flying in light rain for the TOP12 flight he took a DSQ from a difficult judging call, but the weather got progressively worse and the racing was called off after the first 4 Pilots had completed their runs. With the discontinuation of racing the results reverted back to the qualification and wild card rounds so after all the DSQ did not affect the final result.



Yoshi says: "Team Muroya will head straight to Detroit after this and make modifications to the plane and prepare really well for the Windsor round".

Next Red Bull Air Race World Championship will be held on 5-6/May at Windsor Canada.
